FOUNDATION 1- Have had exciting time at the beach as a follow up of the topic on seaside. They have learnt about various sea animals through songs and stories and had first hand experience of seeing and engaging in handling different textured material such as water, sand, stones have given opportunity to talk, explore and learning extended vocabulary. They also had an experience of looking at boat and ferries on a trip to Tanga port. How exciting to walk through long grass and field to look at grasshoppers, butterflies, and bugs of various size and colour.
