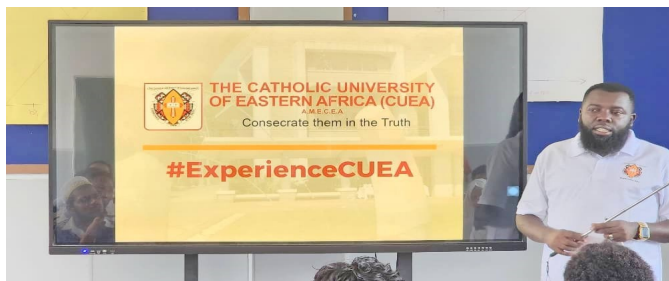
QUEST TRAINING
